### **Drug Screening**

We realize that drug screening can be viewed as invasive, but it is beneficial in several ways and ultimately is designed to ensure that you receive the best care possible. Drug screening promotes honesty in the relationship between the patient and the provider. It also tells the provider how your body is reacting to the drugs you have been prescribed, and whether or not you are taking them as directed so that you receive the maximum benefit.

Be sure you tell your Saluda Center provider about any and all medications you are taking, regardless of who prescribed them. This allows your provider to make the best possible and most informed decisions regarding your care.

Drug screens are to be completed on all patients at The Saluda Center who receive prescriptions, regardless of the type of medications being prescribed.

Your prescriptions may be discontinued, or you may be subject to discharge, if your drug screen shows evidence that your prescription is not being taken as directed, or if it shows evidence of the use of narcotics, opioids, methamphetamines, or any illicit drugs.

Refusal to comply with drug screening may mean that you will not be seen that day. Continuous refusal can result in discharge from The Saluda Center.
